



#### Benefits of the WAGE\$® program


- 95% felt more satisfied with their jobs.

- 94% found the WAGE\$ supplement helped ease financial stress.
- 94% found WAGE\$ encouraged them to stay with their current programs.
- **85%** found the WAGE\$ supplement helped provide more resources for their programs or classrooms.
- 86% found participation in WAGE\$ had improved the quality of their work.
- **97%** felt the WAGE\$ program has an important impact in the early childhood field.
